- ★ **A recommendation for a California Clear Credential or Intern Certificate** upon program completion

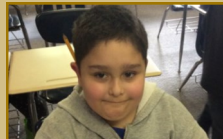
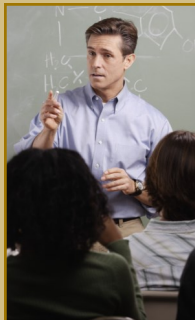
